



<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Maths</u></p> <p>Subtraction – Review subtraction with more than one exchange. Efficient subtraction, estimating and checking answers.</p> <p>Area – Counting area in squares, making shapes and comparing areas.</p> <p>Multiplication and Division – Multiples of 3, multiplying and dividing by 6, 9 and 7. Times table and division facts for 6, 9, 7, 11 and 12. Multiplying by 1 and 0. Dividing by 1 and itself. Multiply three numbers.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p>Information reports – Discuss, research, record and present information organised in paragraphs around a theme (mammals) to create interesting ‘fact files’.</p> <p>Greek Myths – Listen to and discuss writing similar to that which children will plan so they can learn structure, vocabulary and grammar. Build varied and rich vocabulary and increase range of sentence structures.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Physical Education</u></p> <p>Dance – Work with a partner or group effectively; knowing how to lead and improvise. Choreographing my own dance and communicating an idea through dance</p> <p>Sports Hall Athletics – Know that changing speed and direction can alter my performance. I know how to throw in different ways. I know how to aim at a target. I know a range of ways to jump.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Science</u></p> <p>States of Matter – Compare and group materials together as solids, liquids or gases. Observe some materials change state when heated or cooled and measure / research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius. Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Religious Education</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">What is the Trinity?</p> <p>Know that Christians believe God is Trinity: Father, Son and Holy Spirit with the Father creating, the Son saving his people and sending the Holy Spirit enabling Christians today to follow Jesus. Christians find understanding God challenging. To try to understand God better, Christians use symbols, metaphors and art.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Computing</u></p> <p>Audio Production – Identify that sound can be recorded. Explain that audio recordings can be edited. Recognise different parts of creating a podcast project. Apply audio editing skills independently. Combine audio to enhance my podcast project. Evaluate the effective use of audio.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Art / Design Technology</u></p> <p>DT – Textiles and fastenings. Identify the features, benefits and disadvantages of a range of fastening types. Write design criteria and design a sleeve that satisfies the criteria. Make a template for their book sleeve. Assemble a case using any stitch they are comfortable with.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>History</u></p> <p>Understand that the Ancient Greeks lived in independent city-states, comparing Athens with Sparta. Alexander the Great was a great warrior and conqueror. Ancient Greeks worshiped many gods; their myths are still read today and they left a legacy that continues to influence how we live and learn.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Music</u></p> <p>Christmas Concert – singing, improving and performing.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Modern Foreign Languages</u></p> <p>Le Régime Méditerranéen – Talking about categories of food, French food vocabulary and adverbs of frequency.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Personal, Social and Health Education</u></p> <p>Valuing Differences – Managing conflict through negotiation and compromise. Knowing there are many ways we can be different (e.g. race, gender and religion). Impact of aggressive behaviour on others. Stereotypes. Friends and acquaintances. Non-verbal signals.</p>
