

# F1 Weekly News



**10.11.25**

**Drawing Club** – this week we will be enjoying story telling. We will use the story of The Magic Porridge Pot and enjoy the story whilst thinking about the characters and the setting. We will create our own ideas of magic potions and what they will do.

**Phonics** – Now that the children have come to the end of the first set of sounds, we will spend the next couple of weeks revisiting the sounds we have learnt. There will be lots of segmenting and blending to read words and using the sounds to make words.

**Maths** – This week, the children will continue to engage with activities that underline the purpose of counting – to find out ‘how many’ objects there are altogether. They will reinforce their understanding of cardinality – that the last number in the count tells us ‘how many’ things there are altogether in a set of objects – and they will further practise their 1:1 correspondence skill, by counting numbers at the same time as moving or tagging objects. A key focus this week is deepening their understanding of 5 as a quantity by linking the number itself to the 5 fingers on one hand. The children will also begin to explore ways to represent numbers to 5 using both their fingers and a number pattern. These key representations will help to underline the ‘fiveness’ of 5 and provide structures that will support later exploration of its composition and its relationships with other numbers.

**Other learning** – we will continue to discuss the school values in more detail. These values are; *Kindness, Friendship, Respect, Responsibility, Honesty, Perseverance, Faith and Forgiveness*.

This week we will focus on **Forgiveness**. We will discuss what this word means and how we can show forgiveness towards someone. We will be looking out for examples of it in and around the classroom.

**Remembrance** – We will learn about this important service and think about its significance. We will find out about the history behind the day and time, along with the reason why we use poppies to help remember. On Tuesday morning we will take place in a whole school remembrance assembly.

**Anti-Bullying Week** - It is Anti-Bullying week this week. In F1 we will link this to our PSHE learning and talk about how we can be kind to each other. We will discuss what to do if someone is making us feel sad and who to talk to.

**Library Volunteers** – We are hoping to begin visiting the local library as soon as we can on alternate Thursdays. To help us walk to the library and possibly other local areas or future trips we need to have some volunteers who can accompany us. If you can help then there is a volunteer procedure that we ask you go through, please contact the school office to let them know you would like to help. Unfortunately, if we do not have enough volunteers then we may not be able to visit the library or local areas etc, so we would really appreciate any help. Thank you!
