We will also begin learning about Measurement (Length and Height/ Mass and Volume).</p> <p>Throughout the term we will play games to develop recall of number bonds and doubles. We will also continue to use 'Mastering Number' daily to develop our understanding of number and increase fluency, problem solving and reasoning.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>English</u></p> <p style="text-align: center;">Writing –Composition</p> <p>We will form simple sentences inspired by a range of images, short stories, experiences and continuous provision. This term we will read, discuss and write recipes and instructions.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Spelling</p> <p>We will continue to spell the Year 1 common exception words and use our phonic knowledge to support spellings. We will learn more about the use of suffixes.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Grammar and Punctuation</p> <p>We will continue to use capital letters and full stops in writing. We will develop our knowledge of question marks and begin to learn the use of an exclamation mark.</p> <p>We will continue to use 'think, say, write, check' when writing in literacy and across the curriculum.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Reading</p> <p>We will continue to apply learnt and new phonics knowledge to decode words.
